Arlington H.S. Student Group's Focus on the National Debt "Problem," Right-On County Young Republican Club Says

Arlington – A student-initiated club at Arlington High School is being hailed by the Dutchess County Young Republican Club for its willingness to educate peers and the community about the problem of our nation's soaring national debt. The group, Young Americans for Liberty – Arlington High School Chapter, plans to show a movie open to the community that examines how America's "spendthrift ways" has led and is leading to "an economic disaster of epic proportions."

The Young American for Liberty club "promotes liberty in all forms in the community and beyond" according to its mission statement that also "recognizes that freedom deserves responsibility" including "high moral character," "integrity," and "principle." The 62-member group plans a non-partisan look at the national debt through a film scheduled for Friday February 27th at 2:30pm. The movie, *I.O.U.S.A.*, is an award-winning documentary that will be shown in the high school's Large Group Instruction Room at 1157 Route 55 in Lagrangeville.

Club Outreach Director Kyle Peabody, an Arlington H.S. Junior, calls the film, "*The Inconvenient Truth of Economics*" equating it with what former Vice President Al Gore's documentary on global warming accomplished to raise public awareness about threats to the environment. Peabody has been active in his quest to make sure the public is invited to preview the movie with the club.

The Young American for Liberty organization is nationwide with chapters spread across the country with a mission to train, educate, and mobilize youth activists committed to "winning on principle."
